The Jewelers Mutual Insurance Company Scholarships are awarded exclusively to eligible dependent children and step-children of non-executive associates employed at Jewelers Mutual Insurance Company for at least one year, as of April 1.

### Eligibility:

Dependent children and step-children of non-executive associates employed at Jewelers Mutual Insurance Company for at least one year, as of April 1, who attends, or plans to attend, an accredited technical college, college or university on a full-time basis. Previous recipients may apply for consideration. **Graduate students are INELIGIBLE to apply.** The ideal candidate will have:

- A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
- Involvement in extracurricular activities and/or employment
- Leadership qualities

### Award Amount:

Up to two scholarship awards of \$2,000, payable at \$1,000 each for first and second semesters for tuition expenses. Students may reapply each year of their undergraduate schooling.

### Selection:

Recipients are selected each spring by the Community Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee.

### Payment Procedure:

Scholarship payments will be released after submission of the following to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region: completed scholarship verification form (located at [www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships](http://www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships)) and verification of full time student status (class schedule with credits listed). For the subsequent semester the student must submit all of the above documentation along with prior semester's grade report (unofficial grade report will suffice). After approval of submitted documentation, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending during each semester. Most communications from the Community Foundation will be via email; *please keep us advised of your current email address.*

### Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to maintain full time student status with a 3.0 GPA at an accredited technical college, college or university.
