



New Holstein School District Community Fund Adam Buechel and Bob Randl Memorial Scholarship

New Holstein High School freshman classmates and friends, Adam Buechel and Bob Randl, died tragically in an ATV accident in September of 1993. The families and friends of Adam and Bob established this scholarship to honor their memories.

Eligibility:

Graduating seniors from New Holstein High School who intend to pursue a post-secondary education at a college, university or technical school. Applicants must have participated in an athletic activity while in high school.

Award Amount:

One non-renewable award of up to \$500 for tuition expenses.

Selection:

Recipients will be selected each spring by the New Holstein High School Scholarship Selection Committee, according to the eligibility criteria. Recipient's application will be forwarded to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region for administration.

Payment Procedure:

Scholarship payments will be released after submission of the following to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region: Completed scholarship verification form (located at www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships), and verification of full time student status (class schedule with credits listed). After approval of submitted documentation, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending during the first semester of the freshman year of college. Most communications between the Community Foundation and the recipient will be via email. *Please keep us advised of your current email address.*

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to enroll as a full time student at an accredited college, university or technical college for the first semester of college. Any request for deferral must be submitted to the Foundation in writing, and may be granted for up to one year at the discretion of the Foundation, in consultation with New Holstein High School.
