

# Joseph N. Berg and Theodore C. Berg Golf Scholarship

The Berg brothers, Joe and Ted, enjoyed the game of golf. Ted was an occasional golfer, while Joe played in several golf leagues and enjoyed playing on all area courses.

Joe was also a lifetime Appleton Wire Works employee. He was involved in his church and was an American Legion and VFW member.

This scholarship was established to provide annual scholarships to both male and female golfers from each of the following high schools in Appleton, WI: Appleton East, North and West, Fox Valley Lutheran and St. Francis Xavier.

#### **Eligibility:**

High school seniors who have achieved good academic standing and plan to attend a college, university or technical college and who have participated on the school's varsity golf team at an Appleton public high school, St. Francis Xavier High School or Fox Valley Lutheran High School. The ideal candidate will demonstrate:

- An enthusiasm for golf
- Intent to continue to play the game competitively or recreationally
- A high regard for teammates
- A high degree of integrity

#### **Award Amount:**

Non-renewable \$2,500 scholarship award to a college, university or technical college for one male and one female graduating high school senior from each of the eligible high schools. A total of 10 awards are possible.

#### Selection:

Recipients are selected in the spring by each individual High School Scholarship Selection Committee.

## **Payment Procedure:**

Scholarship payments will be released after submission of the following to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region: completed scholarship verification form (located at <a href="https://www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships">www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships</a>) along with verification of full time student status (class schedule with credits listed). After approval of submitted documentation, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending during the first semester of the freshman year of college. This scholarship cannot be deferred. Most communications between the Community Foundation and the student will be via email. *Please keep us advised of your current email address*.

### Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student for the first semester of freshman year of college.
