### Eligibility:

Graduating seniors from Chilton High School who plan to attend an accredited university, college, or technical college. The ideal recipient will have demonstrated the following:

- Helpful
- Friendly
- Kind hearted

### Award Amount:

One non-renewable \$500 scholarship award for tuition expenses.

### Selection:

Selection will be made by the Chilton High School Scholarship Selection Committee and the recipient's application will be forwarded to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region.

### Payment Procedure:

Scholarship payments will be released after submission of the following to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region: completed scholarship verification form (located at [www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships](http://www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships)) and verification of full time student status (class schedule with credits listed). After approval of submitted documentation, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending during the first semester of the freshman year of college. This scholarship cannot be deferred. Most communications between the Community Foundation and the student will be via email. *Please keep us advised of your current email address.*

### Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student for the first semester of freshman year of college.
