



New Holstein School District Community Fund New Holstein High School Alumni Scholarship

In the summer of 1987 a long-time counselor at New Holstein High School, David Ditter, began writing letters to past graduates hoping to start an alumni scholarship fund. The response was overwhelming making it possible for the establishment of a permanent fund that awards scholarships each year. Graduates of New Holstein High School continue to support this worthy cause.

Eligibility:

Graduating seniors from New Holstein High School who intend to pursue a post-secondary education at a college, university or technical school. Applicants must rank in the upper 60% of their class.

Award Amount:

Two non-renewable awards of up to \$750 will be awarded to students attending a four-year college or university.

One non-renewable award of up to \$750 will be awarded to a student attending a technical college.

Selection:

Recipients will be selected each spring by the New Holstein High School Scholarship Selection Committee, according to the eligibility criteria. Recipient's application will be forwarded to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region for administration.

Payment Procedure:

Scholarship payments will be released after submission of the following to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region: Completed scholarship verification form (located at <u>www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships</u>), and verification of full time student status (class schedule with credits listed). After approval of submitted documentation, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending during the first semester of the freshman year of college. Most communications between the Community Foundation and the recipient will be via email. *Please keep us advised of your current email address.*

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to enroll as a full-time student at an accredited college, university or technical college for the first semester of college. Any request for deferral must be submitted to the Foundation in writing and may be granted for up to one year at the discretion of the Foundation, in consultation with New Holstein High School.
