

Oliver E. Sweikar Scholarship

Eligibility:

Graduating seniors planning to pursue a career in electronics, electrical engineering, or related field, from the following high schools in Manitowoc County: Mishicot, Two Rivers, Valders, Manitowoc Lutheran, Manitowoc Lincoln, Roncalli, Reedsville and Kiel. The ideal recipient will have:

- Maintained a minimum cumulative 2.5 GPA
- Demonstrate financial need

Award Amount:

Number of awards may vary.

\$2,000 per semester renewable scholarship, for up to 4 years, for students attending a four-year college or university (total \$16,000)

\$1,000 per semester renewable scholarship, for up to 2 years, for students attending a two-year technical college (total \$4,000)

Selection:

Recipients are selected each spring by the Community Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee.

Payment Procedure:

Scholarship payments will be released after submission of the following to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region: completed scholarship verification form (located at <u>www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships</u>), proof of major and verification of full time student status (class schedule with credits listed). For subsequent payments the student must submit all of the above documentation along with prior semester's grade report (unofficial grade report will suffice). After approval of submitted documentation, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending during first and second semesters. Most communications between the Community Foundation and the student will be via email; *please keep us advised of your current email address.*

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to maintain full-time status majoring in electronics, electrical engineering, or a related field, as a student in good academic standing.

Students changing their major should contact the Community Foundation to verify continued eligibility.
