INITIAL SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT WILL BE SELECTED IN 2017

Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary exists to fulfill the Great Commission by preparing pastors to spread the gospel of Jesus Christ throughout the world. Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary's mission is to train men to enter the pastoral ministry of the Wisconsin Evangelical Lutheran Synod (WELS) and to offer opportunities for theological and professional growth to all called workers.

To promote this mission through Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary and to offer specific encouragement to individual students at the Seminary, *Proverbs 23:26 Scholarship* has been established.

Eligibility:

Graduates of Martin Luther College (or any other college of ministry operated by WELS), who are pursuing theological training through Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary in preparation to enter the pastoral ministry of WELS. Priority will be given to recipients of the *Ephesians 4:11-13 Scholarship*, a scholarship awarded to graduates of Fox Valley Lutheran High School, Appleton, WI, in support of their first year at Martin Luther College.

Award Amount:

The award amount may vary. Typically, the award will be up to \$1,500 for a student entering his junior year at Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary.

Selection:

Recipient(s) will be selected annually by the financial aid committee and administration of Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary. The following will be taken into consideration during the selection process:

- Priority will be given to recipients of the Ephesians 4:11-13 Scholarship, a scholarship awarded to
 graduates of Fox Valley Lutheran High School, Appleton, WI, in support of their first year at Martin
 Luther College. The Financial Aid Officer at the Seminary will be notified of each year's recipient of
 the Ephesians 4:11-13 Scholarship by the Fox Valley Lutheran High School selection committee.
- If no recipients of the *Ephesians 4:11-13 Scholarship* are enrolled as juniors at the Seminary, or if a recipient of the scholarship discontinues study at the Seminary, the scholarship may be awarded to another student based on financial need and academic merit.
- If multiple *Ephesians 4:11-13 Scholarship* recipients enroll as juniors in the same year, the award amount will be divided equally among the recipients.

Payment Procedure:

Scholarship payments will be released after submission of the following to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region: completed scholarship verification form (located at www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships) along with verification of full-time student status at Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary (class schedule with credits listed). After approval of submitted documentation, the scholarship check will be paid directly to Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary. This scholarship cannot be deferred. Most communications between the Community Foundation and the student will be via email. *Please keep us advised of your current email address.*

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register and enroll as a full-time student at Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary.
