



Brenda Strey Memorial Scholarship

Brenda Strey, wife, daughter, sister, aunt and mother of three, passed away in February 2008 after a four-year battle with colon cancer.

Brenda was employed at Schenck where she was well loved and recognized for her hard work, dedication and positive attitude.

Brenda served on the Quarry Quest event committee and volunteered at the event every year. Quarry Quest was created by a team of community organizations in 1998 to help provide a better understanding of the construction and mining industries while also raising funds for local charitable organizations. Neenah High School technical education students built the Strey Educational Center at Michels Materials to house supplies for Quarry Quest and provide a meeting place for the committee.



When Brenda passed away the Quarry Quest committee established this scholarship to memorialize Brenda's life by rewarding hard working, dedicated New London High School students that desire to continue their education at a college or university to study earth science, the environment or a construction-related field.

Eligibility:

Graduating high school senior from New London High School who is planning to pursue a 2-year or 4-year degree in earth science, environment or construction-related studies.

Award Amount:

One \$500 non-renewable scholarship award for tuition expenses.

Selection:

Recipients are selected each spring by the New London High School Scholarship Selection Committee.

Payment Procedure:

Scholarship payments will be released after submission of the following to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region: completed scholarship verification form (located at www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships), verification of full time student status (class schedule with credits listed) and proof of major. After approval of submitted documentation, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending in the first semester. This scholarship cannot be deferred. Most communications between the Community Foundation and the student will be via email; *please keep us advised of your current email address.*

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student pursuing a degree in earth science, environment or construction-related studies for the first semester of college.
