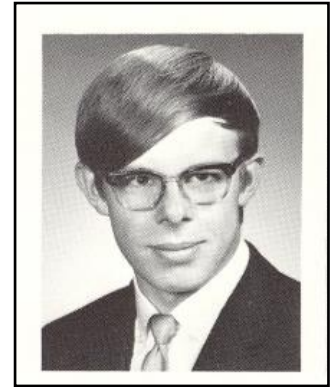




Dale T. Ehnert Scholarship

Dale T. Ehnert was a 1968 graduate of Kiel High School, where he participated in football and basketball. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army, serving his country from January 1970 – February 1972, with a tour of duty during the Vietnam War. He was a member of the Operating Engineers Union, and operated heavy equipment after returning from service. Dale passed away in 2014 at the age of 64, while residing at the Wisconsin Veterans Home in King, WI. Dale often wished that he had continued his education. With this scholarship, it is his hope that others might receive the advanced education that he could not.



Eligibility:

Graduating seniors from Waupaca High School who are planning to attend an accredited technical school to pursue post-secondary education. The following will be taken into consideration to determine the recipient:

- Student who has excelled in Career and Technical education
- Demonstration of excellent employability skills through great attendance and a hard work ethic
- Financial need may be a consideration

Award Amount:

Two \$3,000 awards for tuition expenses, payable as \$1,500 for the first and second semesters of the first year of technical school.

Selection:

Recipients will be selected each spring by the Waupaca High School Foundation Scholarship Committee.

Payment Procedure:

First semester scholarship payments will be released after submission of the following to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region: Completed scholarship verification form (located on our website at www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships) and verification of full time student status (class schedule with credits listed). All of the above documentation will be required for the second semester payment along with recipient's first semester's grade report (unofficial grade report will suffice). After approval of submitted documentation, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending in the first and second semesters. Most communications between the Community Foundation and the student will be via email; *please keep us advised of your current email address.*

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to maintain full time student status in good academic standing at an accredited technical college.
