

Appleton Rotary Foundation Scholarship Semi-finalists will be interviewed

Eligibility:

Graduating high school seniors of an Appleton public or private high school, including high school home schooling programs accredited by the Appleton Area School District, who plan to pursue a bachelor's degree at an accredited college or university. Members of the Rotary Club of Appleton and their families are not eligible to apply. The selection process will be based on the following:

- Applicants are in the top 50% of their high school class
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 thru December 31
- A commitment to community service
- Demonstrated financial need

Award Amount:

Up to three recipients will be selected to receive a \$1,000 per year renewable award for up to 4 years (total \$4,000), for tuition expenses to an accredited college or university.

Selection:

Recipients are selected each spring by the Appleton Rotary Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee and the Community Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee. Semi-finalists will be required to interview with the committee.

Payment Procedure:

Scholarship payments will be released after submission of the following to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region: completed scholarship verification form (located at <u>www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships</u>) and verification of full time student status (class schedule with credits listed). For subsequent years the student must submit all of the above documentation along with prior year's grade report (unofficial grade report will suffice). After approval of submitted documentation, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending during the first semester. Most communications between the Community Foundation and the student will be via email; *please keep us advised of your current email address*.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to maintain a full time student status within an accredited college or university, with a minimum 2.75 GPA on a 4.0 scale, each year.
