Eligibility:

Upon application for the scholarship, the student will be a participant in the Insurance and Financial Planning Minor program offered at the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh. Previous recipients may reapply. The ideal recipient will have demonstrated:

- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
- Leadership skills in student organizations or extracurricular activities
- Core values in alignment with those emphasized in SECURA's core principles
- Preference may be given to students whose primary residency is in one of the following WI counties: Brown, Calumet, Fond du Lac, Outagamie, Waupaca, Waushara, or Winnebago

Award Amount:

Two recipients will each receive a \$1,000 scholarship award for tuition expenses.

Selection:

Recipients are selected each spring by a selection committee within UW Oshkosh and the Community Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee.

Payment Procedure:

Scholarship payments will be released upon submission of the following to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region: completed scholarship verification form (located at www.cfoxvalley.org/scholarships), verification of full time student status (class schedule with credits listed), and proof of participation in the Insurance and Financial Planning Minor program at UW Oshkosh. After approval of submitted documentation, the scholarship check will be paid directly to UW Oshkosh. Most communications between the Community Foundation and the student will be via email; ***please keep us advised of your current email address.***

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register for the fall semester as a full-time student in the Insurance and Financial Planning Minor program at UW Oshkosh.
