

Earl A. and Elaine M. Fetting Scholarship

Dr. Earl A. Fetting graduated from Appleton West High School, attended Lawrence University and then transferred to Marquette School of Dentistry where he graduated in 1946. He also served with the U.S. Navy during WW II and interned at the Forsyth Dental Infirmary, in Boston. Dr. Fetting practiced dentistry in Sheboygan from 1949 – 1951 and in Appleton until his retirement in 1990.

Elaine loved to sing and studied voice privately at the Wisconsin Conservatory of Music and the Lawrence University Conservatory of Music. She performed in several operas at Lawrence University and sang lead parts in musicals with Attic Theater and The Riverside Players. Elaine also presented programs with children for the Appleton Memorial Hospital Auxiliary called “Petite Musicals.” This was one of her favorite activities.

Elaine and Earl enjoyed 47 years of happiness together until his passing in 2001. Prior to Elaine’s death in 2016, she initiated a bequest to establish this scholarship fund to support Fox Valley students who plan to attend Marquette University’s School of Dentistry with tuition costs.



Eligibility:

Graduates of a Wisconsin, Fox Valley High School, who have been accepted into Marquette University’s School of Dentistry. Primary consideration is for students with financial need for tuition, not room and board or books. Preference will be given to graduates of Fox Valley Lutheran High School, Appleton. This is a non-renewable scholarship, but students may be awarded this for multiple years. If there are no current students, that are qualified, in the graduate dental program, then scholarships may be awarded to undergraduate students at Marquette University who are working towards admittance into the dental program.

Award Amount:

Amount will vary for this non-renewable award. More than one scholarship may be awarded per year.

Selection:

Selection will be made by staff at Marquette University School of Dentistry on an annual basis.

Payment Procedure:

Scholarship payments will be released after submission of the following to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region: completed scholarship verification form (located at www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships) and class schedule for the upcoming fall semester. After approval of submitted documentation, the scholarship check will be paid directly to Marquette University. Most communications between the Community Foundation and the student will be via email. *Please keep us advised of your current email address.*
