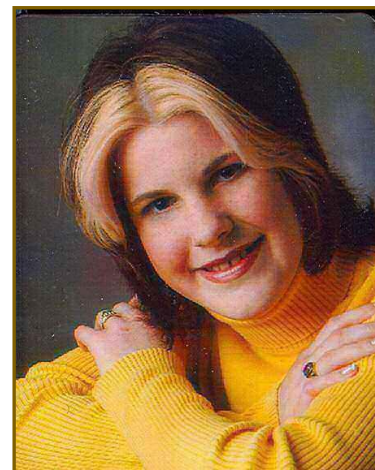


Elizabeth Guttenberg Memorial Scholarship

She was also a member of Memorial Presbyterian Church, where for 4 years she played in the hand bell choir.

In 2005, this scholarship was established by her parents, in loving memory of their daughter, with additional contributions from her relatives, friends, faculty and classmates at UW-Fox Valley.

Eligibility:

Students who will be attending the UWO-Fox Cities campus full-time (minimum 12 credits per semester).

- May be a graduating high school senior
- May be a current or transfer student
- Studying toward a degree in Art or Theatre
- Financial need may be considered

Award Amount:

One \$500 non-renewable scholarship award, payable during the fall semester.

Selection:

Recipients are selected each spring by the UWO-Fox Cities campus scholarship selection committee.

Payment Procedure:

Scholarship payments will be released after submission of the following to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region: completed scholarship verification form (located at www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships), verification of full-time student status (class list with credits) at UWO-Fox Cities campus, and proof of major. After approval of submitted documentation, the scholarship check will be paid directly to UWO Cashier’s Office, designated for the UWO-Fox Cities campus. This scholarship cannot be deferred. Most communications between the Community Foundation and the student will be via email; ***please keep us advised of your current email address.***

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student (minimum 12 credits) pursuing a degree in Art or Theatre at the UWO-Fox Cities campus.
