

## J. C. Bubolz Memorial Scholarship

Julius Christian Bubolz (III) was born in 1893, the 5th in a family of 13 children. Like many of his generation, he had limited opportunity to extend his education beyond 8th grade. JC was able to attend the Auto Institute in Detroit to learn mechanics and sales, but service in World War I interrupted his work with the Studebaker Corporation. However, learning, if only self-taught, remained a life-long endeavor.



JC bought a small farm in Langlade County where he specialized in breeding quality dairy stock. He built all the buildings for his farm with his own hands at night while working as a foreman for the Chicago & Northwestern Railroad during the day. JC served as a Justice of the Peace for Town of Wolf River, operated an insurance agency for farmers from his home, and served 11 years on the school board for the Hollister School District. During his tenure the grade school was recognized as one of the best organized in the state. There were no school buses in the Hollister District, so he used his own vehicle to deliver students, not just his own three children, to the school. He was intent that a lack of transportation should not interfere with a child's access to an education.

JC was deeply proud that his son and two daughters were able to achieve college degrees and it is our family's wish that we honor him by providing others some assistance through the JC Bubolz Memorial Scholarship, as they pursue their own educations.

### Eligibility:

Students who will be attending the UWO-Fox Cities campus full-time (minimum 12 credits per semester), pursuing any major offered at UWO-Fox Cities campus.

- May be a graduating high school senior
- May be a current or transfer student
- Maintained a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA
- Must demonstrate financial need

### Award Amount:

Two \$1,000 scholarship awards, payable at \$500 each for the fall and spring semesters.

### Selection:

Recipients are selected each spring by the UWO-Fox Cities campus scholarship selection committee.

### Payment Procedure:

Scholarship payments will be released after submission of the following to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region: completed scholarship verification form (located at [www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships](http://www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships)), and verification of full-time student status (class list with credits) at UWO-Fox Cities campus. For subsequent semester students must submit all the above documentation along with prior semester's grade report (unofficial grade report will suffice). After approval of submitted documentation, the scholarship check will be paid directly to UWO Cashier's Office, designated for the UWO-Fox Cities campus. This scholarship cannot be deferred. Most communications between the Community Foundation and the student will be via email; ***please keep us advised of your current email address.***

### Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time (minimum 12 credits) student attending the UWO-Fox Cities campus.
