

## Miller Electric Manufacturing Company Scholarship Fund

Miller Electric Manufacturing Company is headquartered in Appleton, WI. It is owned by Illinois Tool Works. Their company goal is to lead the welding industry by building "advanced, solution focused products and meeting crucial needs for welding safety". They credit their success to the quality of their people working together with their customers and distribution partners to build a "bigger, better, brighter world". Miller Electric Manufacturing Company Scholarship is provided primarily to promote engineering as a major at UW-Fox. It is also used as a recruiting tool to introduce new students who are women and/or ethnic minorities to the idea of choosing an engineering major by supporting their introduction to college and making it more affordable economically.

### Eligibility:

Students who will be attending UWO-Fox Cities campus with a minimum of 9 credits per semester, pursuing a degree in engineering.

- May be a graduating high school senior who has maintained a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA
- May be a current or transfer student who has maintained a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA
- New students must have completed high school level Trigonometry
- Continuing students must show progress in completing required courses toward an Engineering degree
- Student must identify as an ethnic minority or female
- Must demonstrate financial need

### Award Amount:

One scholarship award, for a minimum of \$2,000. Students must maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA.

### Selection:

Recipients are selected each spring by the UWO-Fox Cities Scholarship Selection Committee.

### Payment Procedure:

Scholarship payments will be released after submission of the following to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region: completed scholarship verification form (located at [www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships](http://www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships)), and verification of enrollment with a minimum of nine credits (class list with credits) and proof of major at UWO-Fox Cities campus. After approval of submitted documentation, the scholarship check will be paid directly to UWO Cashier's Office, designated for UWO-Fox Cities campus. This scholarship cannot be deferred. Most communications between the Community Foundation and the student will be via email; ***please keep us advised of your current email address.***

### Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a student with a minimum of 9 credits attending UWO-Fox Cities campus pursuing a degree in engineering and maintaining a 3.0 GPA.
