



Patricia A. Warrick Scholarship

This scholarship was established in 2006 by Emeritus Professor of English, Patricia Warrick, who began teaching at UW-Fox Valley in 1966 and retired in 1996.

Eligibility:

New or continuing full-time student attending UWO-Fox Cities campus pursuing any major.

Award Amount:

One \$1,500 scholarship award payable at \$750 in the fall and spring semesters.

Selection:

Recipients are selected each spring by the UWO-Fox Cities campus scholarship selection committee.

Payment Procedure:

Scholarship payments will be released after submission of the following to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region: completed scholarship verification form (located at www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships), verification of full-time student status (class list with credits) at UWO-Fox Cities campus. For subsequent semesters students must submit all the above documentation along with prior semester's grade report (unofficial grade report will suffice). After approval of submitted documentation, the scholarship check will be paid directly to UWO Cashier's Office, designated for the UWO-Fox Cities campus. This scholarship cannot be deferred. Most communications between the Community Foundation and the student will be via email; please-keep us advised of your current email address.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student (minimum 12 credits) at UWO-Fox Cities campus.
