

## Verne Imhoff Scholarship

This scholarship was established in 2006 through a generous bequest made by Vivian K. Imhoff, the wife of LaVerne J. Imhoff, the first full-time director at the University of Wisconsin-Fox Valley. He served the university from 1957-65 and was instrumental in leading the campus to its present location. Dr. Imhoff passed away in May 1997.

### Eligibility:

Students who will be attending UWO-Fox Cities campus as a part-time (minimum 6 credits) or full-time (minimum 12 credits) student.

- May be a graduating high school senior
- May be a current or transfer student
- Financial need is a consideration

### Award Amount:

One \$1,500 scholarship award payable at \$750 in the fall and spring semesters.

### Selection:

Recipients are selected each spring by the UWO-Fox Cities campus scholarship selection committee.

### Payment Procedure:

Scholarship payments will be released after submission of the following to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region: completed scholarship verification form (located at [www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships](http://www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships)), verification of student status (class list with credits) at UWO-Fox Cities campus. For subsequent semesters students must submit all the above documentation along with prior semester's grade report (unofficial grade report will suffice). After approval of submitted documentation, the scholarship check will be paid directly to UWO Cashier's Office, designated for the UWO-Fox Cities campus. This scholarship cannot be deferred. Most communications between the Community Foundation and the student will be via email; ***please keep us advised of your current email address.***

### Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register for classes at UWO-Fox Cities campus.
