

William Guither Science Scholarship

This scholarship was originally established in 1981 as a physical science scholarship by the physical science faculty and staff. In 1989, additional funds were raised to endow the scholarship and rename it in honor of Emeritus Professor William Guither as a gift presented to him upon his retirement.

Eligibility:

Continuing full-time students attending the UWO- Fox Cities campus and pursuing a major in the sciences.

- Students must have a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA
- Students must have declared a major in the sciences (biological, chemical, computer, geological, mathematical, physical or any majors which fall under this division)
- Students must be attending UWO-Fox Cities campus as a full-time student (minimum 12 credits per semester)

Award Amount:

One \$2,000 scholarship award, payable at \$1,000 each for the fall and spring semesters.

Selection:

Recipients are selected each spring by the UWO-Fox Cities campus scholarship selection committee.

Payment Procedure:

Scholarship payments will be released after submission of the following to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region: completed scholarship verification form (located at www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships), verification of full-time student status (class list with credits) and proof of major at UWO-Fox Cities campus. For subsequent semesters students must submit all the above documentation along with prior semester's grade report (unofficial grade report will suffice). After approval of submitted documentation, the scholarship check will be paid directly to UWO Cashier's Office, designated for the UWO-Fox Cities campus. This scholarship cannot be deferred. Most communications between the Community Foundation and the student will be via email; ***please keep us advised of your current email address.***

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student with a minimum of 12 credits per semester, major in the sciences, maintaining a minimum 3.0 GPA and attending UWO-Fox Cities campus.
