

Minock Nursing Scholarship

This scholarship was established in 2002 by Emeritus Professor of Biological Sciences, Michael Minock.

Eligibility:

Continuing or transfer student attending UWO-Fox Cities campus full-time (minimum 12 credits per semester), planning to pursue a four-year degree in nursing.

- Continuing student who will be entering their 2nd year
- Must have completed 24 credits by the end of their first year, which include pre-nursing courses
- Must intend to pursue a four-year degree in nursing
- Minimum 3.0 GPA, including a B average in pre-nursing courses
- Financial need may be considered

Award Amount:

One \$750 non-renewable scholarship award, payable during the fall semester.

Selection:

Recipients are selected each spring by the UWO-Fox Cities campus scholarship selection committee.

Payment Procedure:

Scholarship payments will be released after submission of the following to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region: completed scholarship verification form (located at www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships), verification of full-time student status (class list with credits) at UWO-Fox Cities campus, and proof of major. After approval of submitted documentation, the scholarship check will be paid directly to UWO Cashier's Office, designated for UWO-Fox Cities campus. This scholarship cannot be deferred. Most communications between the Community Foundation and the student will be via email; ***please keep us advised of your current email address.***

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student (minimum 12 credits) at UWO-Fox Cities campus, pursuing a 4-year degree in nursing minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA for freshman year.
