### Eligibility:

Students attending UWO-Fox Cities campus full-time (minimum 12 credits) and participating in one or more performing arts courses (concert band, jazz band, choir, theater).

- Minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA
- Financial need may be considered

### Award Amount:

One \$500 non-renewable scholarship award, payable after successful completion of first semester.

### Selection:

Recipients are selected each spring by the UWO-Fox Cities campus scholarship selection committee.

### Payment Procedure:

After successful completion of first semester, scholarship payments will be released upon submission of the following to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region: completed scholarship verification form (located at [www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships](http://www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships)), verification of full-time student status for second semester (class list with credits) at UWO-Fox Cities campus, first semester grade transcript and proof of major. After approval of submitted documentation, the scholarship check will be paid directly to UWO Cashier's Office, designated for the UWO-Fox Cities campus. This scholarship cannot be deferred. Most communications between the Community Foundation and the student will be via email; **please keep us advised of your current email address.**

### Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student (minimum 12 credits) participating in one or more performing arts courses at UWO-Fox Cities campus and have maintained a 3.0 GPA for 1<sup>st</sup> semester.
