
"Josh had many characteristics such as discipline, sacrifice, accountable, hard worker and adapting to others," said his wrestling coach.

Eligibility:

Graduating seniors who have participated all four years on either the Hilbert High School Football Team or the Chilton/Hilbert High School Wrestling Team. Applicants must have a minimum 3.0 GPA and plan to attend an accredited 2- or 4-year college, university or technical college. Applicants should have the following characteristics:

- Independent and dedicated
- Hard worker
- Personable and driven

Award Amount:

One non-renewable \$500 award to be used for tuition expenses after successful completion of first semester of post-secondary school.

Selection:

Recipients are selected each spring by representatives from Hilbert and Chilton High Schools and one of Josh's family members, along with the Community Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee.

Payment Procedure:

After successful completion of 1st semester, scholarship payments will be released after submission of the following to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region: completed scholarship verification form (located at www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships), verification of full-time student status for the second semester (class list with credits listed), and first semester grade report (unofficial grade report will suffice). After approval of submitted documentation, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending during the second semester of post-secondary school. This scholarship cannot be deferred. Most communications between the Community Foundation and the student will be via email. *Please keep us advised of your current email address.*

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA in the first semester of post-secondary school and enroll in second semester as a full-time student.
