

The Doug & Carla Salmon Foundation Scholarship For Students Attending UWO-Fox Cities Campus

The Salmons moved to Appleton in 1972 to work in the medical field and raise their two children. In the late 1990s, Doug and Carla began to explore ways to give back to the community that had been so good to them. They concluded that the most meaningful work they could do would be of offer a helping hand to worthy students.

In 1999, they began to provide scholarship assistance to highly motivated college students who need financial assistance. By 2002, the Salmons were working with foundations at UW-Fox Valley, Fox Valley Technical College and UW-Oshkosh to provide scholarships. Lakeland University students have also benefitted.



In 2002, Doug and Carla formed the Doug & Carla Salmon Foundation, a supporting organization within the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region. Through this partnership, they are able to fulfill their passion for sharing with others for generations to come. Doug passed away in November 2017, and The Doug & Carla Salmon Foundation Scholarships are his living legacy that will continue to help students in the future.

Eligibility:

Highly motivated undergraduate students who will be attending UWO-Fox Cities campus particularly those majoring in nursing, education, business (especially accounting) or medical technology, who have a demonstrated need for financial assistance. Preference may be given to single parents, first generation college students, older students and those who are overcoming significant financial, social, emotional or physical barriers to success.

Award Amount:

Number and amount of awards may vary. Typically, between \$500 and \$1,500 per semester for tuition expenses. Based upon student performance, financial need and availability of funding, this scholarship may be renewable.

Selection:

Selection will be made by the Doug & Carla Salmon Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee along with the Community Foundation. Interviews will be held for finalists.

Payment Procedure:

Scholarship payments will be released after submission of the following to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region: completed scholarship verification form (located at www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships) along with verification of student status (class list with credits). After approval of submitted documentation, the scholarship check will be paid directly to UWO Cashier's Office designated for UWO-Fox Cities campus. This scholarship cannot be deferred. Most communications between the Community Foundation and the student will be via email. *Please keep us advised of your current email address.*

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a student for classes at UWO-Fox Cities campus.
