



Bear Paw Resort Scholarship

Bear Paw Outdoor Adventure Center is located in White Lake, Wisconsin. The owners, Thomas Kreif and Eric Scharenbrock, are passionate about education and helping students attain post-secondary schooling. This scholarship was established for the benefit of White Lake High School graduating seniors.

Eligibility:

Graduating White Lake High School students who would like to further their education by pursuing post-secondary education at a one-, two-, or four-year post-secondary educational school, including certificate programs.

Award Amount:

Up to \$1,000 award for tuition, payable after successful completion of the 1st semester of post-secondary schooling.

Selection:

Recipients will be selected each fall by the White Lake High School Scholarship Selection Committee.

Payment Procedure:

Scholarship payments will be released after submission of the following to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region: completed scholarship verification form (located at www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships) and verification of full-time student status (class schedule with credits listed), along with first semester grade transcripts. After approval of submitted documentation, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending for second semester. This scholarship cannot be deferred. Most communications between the Community Foundation and the student will be via email. *Please keep us advised of your current email address.*

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to complete the first semester as a full-time student in good academic standing and register as a full-time student for second semester of post-secondary education.
