

Clintonville Area Foundation Tiny Truckers Early Childhood Education Scholarship

Background:

Tiny Truckers Day Care Center was established in 1979 as a non-profit organization with a goal to provide safe, affordable, high-quality childcare and give each child a warm environment that encouraged the development of socialization skills, independence, and a positive self- image.

Tiny Truckers meant a lot to the community of Clintonville. After 40 years it became difficult to find the help needed to continue with the program. On Friday, October 26, 2018, Tiny Truckers Day Care Center held their final day of business.



This scholarship was established to support graduates of Clintonville High School who will be pursuing a degree in early childhood education. Preference will be given to students who attended Tiny Truckers Day Care Center.

Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Graduating senior from Clintonville High School
- Pursuing a career in **early childhood education**. (*Early childhood education is a branch of education theory which relates to the teaching of children from birth up to the age of eight which is traditionally about third grade.*)
- Planning to attend a college, university, or technical school
- Preference given to students who attended Tiny Truckers Day Care

Award Amount:

One \$1,000 non-renewable scholarship award to be used for tuition expenses for the first semester of college.

Selection:

Recipients will be recommended each spring by the Clintonville High School Scholarship Selection Committee.

Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the [Scholarship Portal](https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar) (<https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar>). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents *as instructed* in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Portal account updated with their current email address.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student pursuing a degree in early childhood education.
