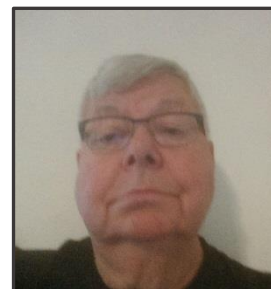


Gary McGoey Scholarship Fund

Gary McGoey graduated from Kaukauna High School in 1961. Living with his mother, who was widowed when Gary was six years old, the family struggled financially. If it wasn't for the University of Wisconsin-Fox Valley, he might never have attended college. He earned a Master of Science degree in counselor education.

As a young person, he did not value the importance of education, but learned later that education is a lifelong pursuit. He feels you must never stop learning. He created this scholarship, along with three others, when he retired and audited classes at UW-Fox Valley and Fox Valley Technical College for a few years. He strongly believes that students should not have to worry about money while facing the pressures to perform well academically.



Eligibility:

Full-time students who will be attending UWO-Fox Cities campus pursuing any major offered at UWO-Fox Cities campus.

- Must demonstrate financial need

Award Amount:

Two \$1,250 scholarship awards, payable for first semester.

Selection:

Recipients are selected each spring by the UWO-Fox Cities campus scholarship selection committee.

Payment Procedure:

Scholarship payments will be released after submission of the following to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region: completed scholarship verification form (located at www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships), and verification of enrollment (class list with credits) at UWO-Fox Cities campus. For subsequent semesters, students must submit all the above documentation along with evidence student is in academic good-standing report (unofficial grade report will suffice). After approval of submitted documentation, the scholarship check will be paid directly to UWO Cashier's Office, designated for UWO-Fox Cities campus. This scholarship cannot be deferred. Most communications between the Community Foundation and the student will be via email; **please keep us advised of your current email address.**

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student attending UWO-Fox Cities campus and maintain academic good-standing.
