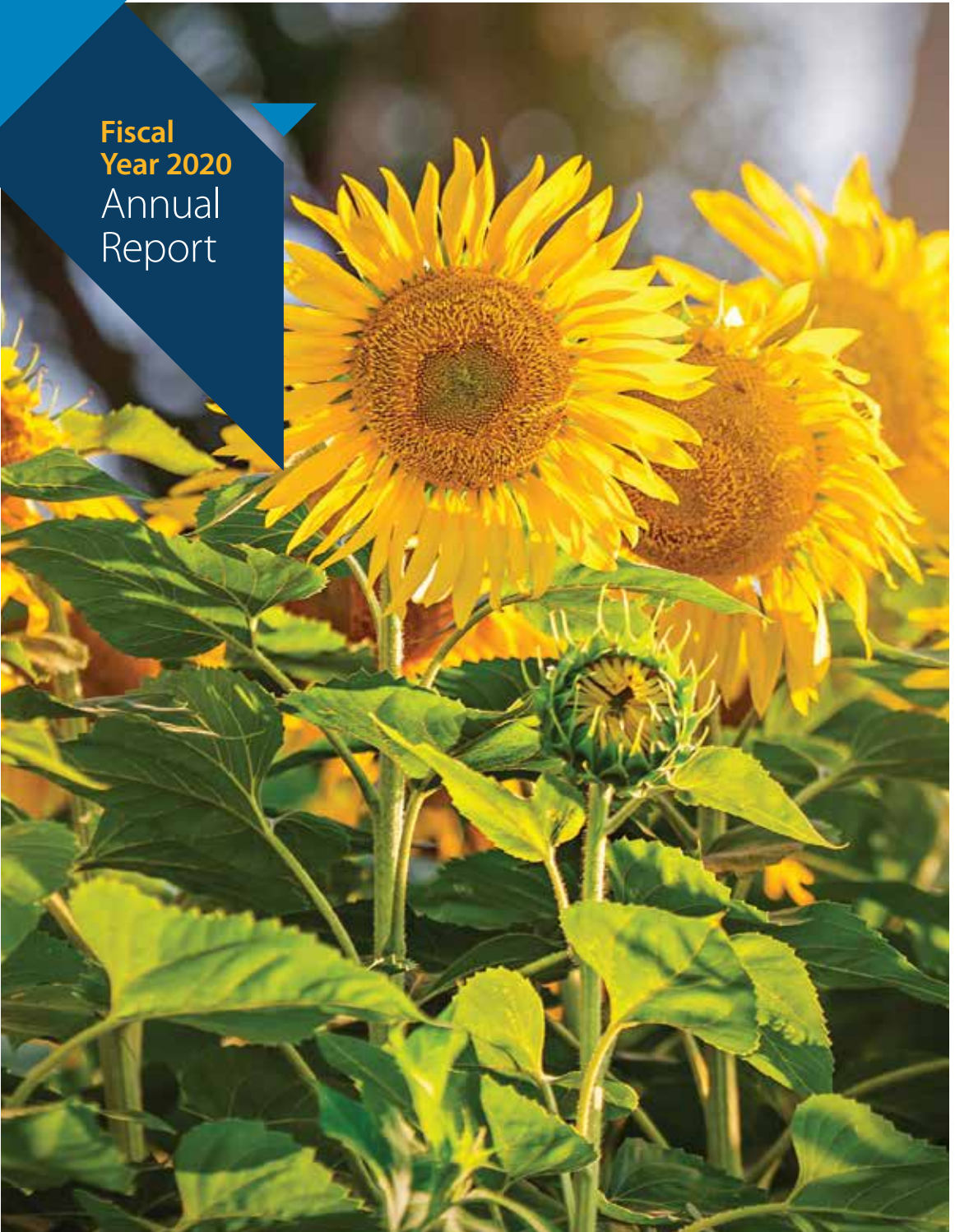

LEAVEN supports basic needs

LEAVEN is an organization that helps those in need navigate challenging times by providing them with limited financial assistance to meet their basic needs. And this year has certainly provided extra challenges for struggling Chilton area households. The reality of the COVID-19 crisis can be felt in their stories:

- "Because of the pandemic I was laid off in March...I am in dire need of rental assistance."
- "I have been unemployed since April 30th and have been waiting to receive payments for over 8 weeks...I am in desperate need of assistance paying my rent and utilities."
- "I have been out of work since May 26th and am down to the last few dollars in my bank account... my spirit has been completely crushed."

The Chilton Area Community Foundation Fund awarded LEAVEN a \$5,000 grant to help our Chilton neighbors who are most in-need during these difficult times. Funds like this have helped LEAVEN provide uninterrupted service.

AEDs at heart of Fire Department grants

Sudden cardiac arrest is one of the leading causes of death in the U.S. In fact, Chilton Fire Department receives several calls for cardiac related emergencies every year. To assist with such emergencies, firefighter emergency medical responders may use automated external defibrillator (AED) devices which are capable of analyzing a person's heart rhythm and, if necessary, deliver an electrical shock (defibrillation) to help establish an effective heart rhythm. A grant of \$5,000 from the Chilton Area Community Foundation Fund was awarded to the department for the purchase of automated external defibrillators. This grant can help people in the Chilton area receive the most effective care from our first responders should a cardiac emergency arise.
