



Ariens Foundation Scholarship Fund

The Ariens Foundation looks for graduating seniors from the Brillion, Chilton, Hilbert, Reedsville, Valders and Wrightstown High Schools as well as locations where AriensCo has remote employees of 1 year or longer. The students should be planning to attend an accredited public, private or sponsored trade school. The Ariens Foundation looks to provide scholarships to the broader community and to the dependents of the Ariens Company family employees. The Foundation's goal is to support young people as they seek to become better educated and therefore productive members of society.

Eligibility:

Dependent high school seniors of employees of AriensCo employed for at least one year at any AriensCo location. Also eligible are graduating seniors from Brillion, Chilton, Hilbert, Reedsville, Valders and Wrightstown High Schools. Students must be planning to attend a 2 or 4-year college, university or technical school full-time. Ariens Foundation offers two types of scholarship awards: *the Ariens Foundation College Scholarship Award* (leading to a bachelor's degree) and *the Ariens Foundation Technical Scholarship Award* (any accredited educational institution for a post-secondary study program). The following will be taken into consideration to determine recipients:

- Demonstrated high academic performance, leadership and participation in high school and community activities.
- Demonstrated motivation to succeed.
- Significant improvement in high school attendance and/or GPA.
- Overcoming a significant obstacle.
- Work experience.

Award Amount:

One-time \$2,000 non-renewable scholarship award for tuition expenses. Number of awards will vary.

Selection:

Recipients are selected each spring by the Ariens Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee within the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region.

Payment Process:

Scholarship payments will be released after successful submission and approval from Community Foundation staff of the online scholarship verification form. Log in to your account on the Community Foundation Web Portal at <https://donor.cffoxvalley.org/SpectrumWebPortal>. Click on Scholarship Applicant, then My Awards. Select the Scholarship Name and then on Follow-up Action, Scholarship Verification Form, towards the bottom of the page. Complete, save and submit the form. The scholarship check will be paid directly to the school you will be attending during the first semester. Most communications between the Community Foundation and the student will be via email. **Please keep us advised of your current email address.**

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student for the first semester of freshman year at an accredited college, university or technical school.
