



Gresham Scholarship Fund

Eligibility:

Graduating high school seniors from Gresham High School who have maintained a minimum cumulative 2.0 grade point average and plan to attend an accredited college, university, technical college, or proprietary school as a full-time student. **Selection will be based on candidates submitting a complete application along with a photo and grade transcripts.** Previous recipients of the Gresham Dollars for Scholars or Gresham Scholarship Fund scholarships are not eligible to apply for this scholarship.

Award Amount:

\$3,250 non-renewable scholarship award for tuition expenses paid after successful completion of first semester of post-secondary schooling.

Recipients can delay receipt of the scholarship award payment up to five years. The reason for the delay must be noted on the application and approved by the Gresham Scholarship Fund's Board of Directors. Acceptable reasons include military service, community service work and missionary work.

Selection:

Recipients will be selected each spring by the Community Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee.

Payment Procedure:

After successful completion of first semester of post-secondary schooling, scholarship payments will be released upon submission and approval of the online scholarship verification form. Log in to your account on the Community Foundation Web Portal at

https://donor.cffoxvalley.org/SpectrumWebPortal. Click on Scholarship Applicant, My Awards. Click on the Scholarship Name and then on the Follow-up Action towards the bottom of the page. Complete, save and submit the online scholarship verification form. The scholarship check will be paid directly to the school you will be attending during the second semester. Most communications between the Community Foundation and the student will be via email. *Please keep us advised of your current email address.*

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to maintain a 2.0 GPA in the first semester of post-secondary school and register as full-time student for the second semester of college.
