



Claire Fell Doherty Nursing Scholarship

Background:

Claire Fell graduated from Kaukauna High School in 1908. She taught country school for a year and then went into nursing training at Trinity Hospital which was related to Marquette University in Milwaukee. She graduated from Trinity in 1912. William Doherty established this scholarship in 1969 in memory of his wife who died that same year. Because there were no Community Foundations in existence in the Kaukauna area in 1969, the scholarship was established with The New Hampshire Charitable Fund, which later became The New Hampshire Charitable Foundation. In 2004, The New Hampshire Charitable Foundation transferred the funds to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region to administer this scholarship. This fund has been awarding scholarships to Kaukauna High School students pursuing a nursing career for close to 50 years!

Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Graduating seniors of Kaukauna High School
- Preference will be given to students planning to enter the nursing profession. If no nursing candidate is available, the selection committee may select a recipient entering another field of study

Award Amount:

One \$500 non-renewable scholarship award.

Selection:

Recipients are recommended each spring by the Kaukauna High School Scholarship Selection Committee.

Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Scholarship payments will be made to Kaukauna High School for disbursement on behalf of the recipient.
