



Shawano Area Community Foundation Curtis Grunewald Rotary Scholarship

Background:

The Curtis Grunewald Rotary Scholarship Fund was established with an initial gift from his wife, Arlene Grunewald, and a supporting gift from the former Bonduel Rotary Club in memory of Curtis. This fund is intended to provide scholarships for students graduating from Bonduel High School who have a promising academic record and who are in need of financial assistance in pursuit of higher education.

Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Graduating seniors from Bonduel High School
- Maintained a minimum 3.0 GPA the last two semesters with a solid trend upward the last two years of high school
- Plan to obtain post-secondary education at a 4-year college or university as a full-time student
- Demonstrates the following: motivated person, active in extra-curricular activities, extremely diversified in interests and has found focus the last year or two of high school

Award Amount:

One \$500 non-renewable scholarship award for tuition expenses payable after successful completion of the first semester.

Selection:

Recipients will be recommended each spring by Bonduel High School Scholarship Selection Committee. A "C" student could be considered for the scholarship if they have diversified interests and have found a sense of focus in the last years of high school.

Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the <u>Scholarship Portal</u> (https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents *as instructed* in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Portal account updated with their current email address.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student for the second semester, at a 4-year college or university, after successful completion of the first semester, as a student in good academic standing.
