



Shawano Area Community Foundation Dean D. Proper Athletic Scholarship

Background:

This scholarship was established to provide awards for athletes graduating from Bonduel High School. It is not intended for the "best athlete." The ideal candidate is one who may have had a hard time excelling at everything since a freshman, due to involvement in a multitude of activities, or the need to help at home. The candidate may not have the highest grades, but is extremely diversified in interests, has found focus the last year or two and has a good trend upward. The heart, focus, and future interests of the student will be considered.

Individuals receiving this scholarship may re-apply each year of undergraduate studies as long as the student's GPA remains at a 3.0 or higher.

Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Graduating seniors from Bonduel High School
- Planning to attend an accredited 4-year college or university as a full-time student
- Maintained 3.0 GPA the last two semesters with a solid trend upward the last two years if grades were previously not at that level
- Excelled in varsity football and at least one other varsity sport for the last three years of high school
- Demonstrates the following: motivated student who has participated in sports and other activities, diversified interests and a sense of focus

Award Amount:

One \$11,000 scholarship award for tuition expenses, payable \$5,500 for the first and second semesters of the freshman year of college.

Selection:

Recipients will be recommended each spring by Bonduel High School Scholarship Selection Committee.

Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the <u>Scholarship Portal</u> (https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents as instructed in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Portal account updated with their current email address.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to remain a full-time student in good academic standing for the first and second semesters of the freshman year of college.
