

Gordy and Mona Van Asten 'Ethics/Entrepreneurship' Fellowship

Background:

The Gordy & Mona Van Asten 'Ethics/Entrepreneurship' Fellowship was created to honor Gordy and Mona's 60th wedding anniversary on May 8, 2012. Together they shared a commitment to family, church and community – the cornerstones of their values. Through this scholarship award, the tradition of excellence and self-emptying service embraced by this exemplary couple will be remembered in perpetuity.



Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Sophomore or junior college students entering their junior or senior year at St. Norbert College as a fulltime student
- Pursuing a degree in Business Administration or Economics
- Minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA for the first 2 years of college
- Demonstrated learning outside the classroom, such as participation in activities, career development, and/or involvement in community service/service to others
- Demonstrated high ethical standard, and knowledge and skill in entrepreneurship
- Students may apply each year they are eligible

Award Amount:

Two \$2,500 non-renewable scholarship awards for tuition expenses for fall semester.

Selection:

Recipients are recommended each spring by Community Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee along with Mike Van Asten.

Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the <u>Scholarship Portal</u> (https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents *as instructed* in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Portal account updated with their current email address.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student entering their junior or senior year at St. Norbert College, in De Pere, Wisconsin, pursuing a degree in Business Administration or Economics.
