



Ralph and Alice (Wall) Bastian Scholarship Fund

Background:

Ralph Bastian and Alice Wall both graduated from Brillion High School, the latter as valedictorian of her class. Alice then graduated from Oshkosh State Teacher's College and taught in the Marinette, Green Bay, Kaukauna, and Kimberly public school systems. Ralph graduated from LaSalle School of Business in Chicago and operated a lifelong retail business in Kaukauna. Both enjoyed music: Alice played piano and organ; Ralph sang in the McDowell Male Chorus and church choir.

This scholarship was established by Dr. Dwight Bastian in honor of his parents, Ralph and Alice (Wall) Bastian.



Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Graduating seniors of Brillion High School
- Planning to pursue a major in the field of business, education, or music at an accredited, nonprofit 2- or 4-year college, university, or technical school
- Minimum cumulative 2.5 GPA
- Involvement in school and community activities
- Demonstrates the following: excitement and passion for the chosen field of study, conscientious and hardworking
- Financial need will be considered

Award Amount:

One \$500 non-renewable scholarship award for tuition expenses.

Selection:

Recipients are recommended each spring by the Brillion High School Scholarship Selection Committee.

Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the [Scholarship Portal](https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar) (<https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar>). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents *as instructed* in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Portal account updated with their current email address.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student for the first semester of freshman year at an accredited, nonprofit college, university or technical school, pursuing a field of study related to Business, Education or Music.
