Background:

Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- When applying for the scholarship, the student needs to be enrolled in the Insurance and Financial Planning Minor program offered at the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh
- Minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA
- Demonstrated leadership skills in student organizations or extracurricular activities, core values in alignment with those emphasized in SECURA's core principles
- Preference may be given to students whose primary residency is in one of the following WI counties: Brown, Calumet, Fond du Lac, Outagamie, Waupaca, Waushara, or Winnebago
- Previous recipients may re-apply each year they are eligible

Award Amount:

Two non-renewable \$1,000 scholarship awards for tuition expenses.

Selection:

Recipients are recommended each spring by a selection committee within UW Oshkosh and the Community Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee.

Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the [Scholarship Portal](https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar) (<https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar>). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents *as instructed* in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Portal account updated with their current email address.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register for the fall semester as a full-time student in the Insurance and Financial Planning Minor program at UW Oshkosh.
