

Shawano Area Community Foundation Strayer Family Scholarship

Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Graduating senior from Bonduel High School
- Planning to attend a 4-year accredited college or university as a full-time student
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 in the last two semesters with a solid trend upward the last two years if grades have not always been at that level
- Academic achievement
- Participation in school activities and other organized activities, volunteering
- Demonstrates the following: well-rounded student, social, community and family interests
- Employment history
- Financial need will be considered

Award Amount:

Up to \$1,000 non-renewable scholarship award for tuition expenses payable for the first semester of college.

Selection:

Recipients will be recommended each spring by Bonduel High School Scholarship Selection Committee.

Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the [Scholarship Portal](https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar) (<https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar>). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents *as instructed* in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Portal account updated with their current email address.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student for the first semester of the freshman year of college.
