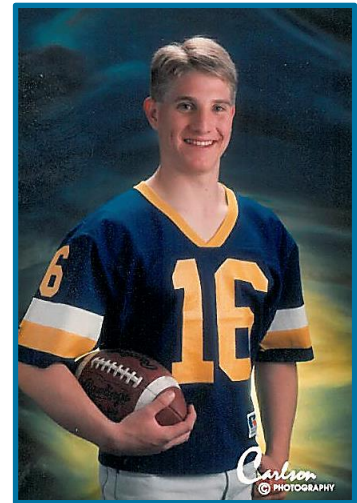


## Chilton Area Community Foundation Tim Reinl Memorial Scholarship

### Background:

The Tim Reinl Memorial Scholarship was established by the Reinl family in memory of their son Tim, a 1995 graduate of Chilton High School. After high school Tim went on to college and graduated from UW Stevens Point in 1999 with a Bachelor of Science Degree. Tim loved sports and throughout high school played tennis, football, baseball and basketball. Tim had many friends and enjoyed life to its fullest. He loved hunting, fishing, and the outdoors. Tim passed away unexpectedly in August of 2001 at the age 24.



### Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients

- Graduating seniors from Chilton High School
- Planning to pursue a post-secondary education at a 2- or 4-year college, university or technical College located in Wisconsin as a full-time student
- Demonstrates the following: friendliness, success in obtaining goals without compromising values and beliefs, willingness to help others, being a sincere individual with a good high school attendance record
- Financial need will be considered

### Award Amount:

One non-renewable \$2,000 scholarship award for tuition expenses.

### Selection:

Recipients will be recommended each spring by the Chilton High School Scholarship Selection Committee.

### Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the [Scholarship Portal](https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar) (<https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar>). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents *as instructed* in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Portal account updated with their current email address.

### Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to enroll as a full-time student for the first semester of college.
