



WEAC-Fox Valley Henry V. Krokosky, Jr. Scholarship

Background:

The WEAC-Fox Valley Henry V. Krokosky, Jr. Scholarship has been established in recognition of the time, education, and service provided by Henry Krokosky in representing WEAC-Fox Valley interests at the local, state, and national levels. This scholarship fund is intended to provide scholarship support to children or legal dependents, meeting the criteria below, of WEAC active or retired members.

Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Graduating high school senior whose parent or legal guardian is a current or retired WEAC member from one of the following school districts:
 - Appleton Area School District
 - Fox Valley Technical College
 - Little Chute Area School District
 - Neenah Joint School District
 - School District of New London
- Planning to attend an accredited 2- or 4-year college, university, or technical school as a full-time student
- High school and community involvement, volunteer history, work experience
- Strong academic performance

Award Amount:

One \$1,250 non-renewable scholarship award for cost of attendance, payable for the first semester of college.

Selection:

Recipients will be recommended by the Community Foundation scholarship selection committee.

Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the [Scholarship Portal](https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar) (<https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar>). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents *as instructed* in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Portal account updated with their current email address.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student at an accredited public or private college, university or technical college.
