

Louis H. and Beula P. Haase College Scholarship

Background:

The Haases were life-long residents of Neenah who ran the Haase Agency. Even though they didn't have children of their own, they wanted to help other families' children go to college. Many students have benefitted from their generosity since the fund was established in September of 2000 with an estate gift after both Louis and Beula had passed away.

Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Graduating high school seniors residing in one of the following communities:
 - o Menasha
 - o Neenah
 - Village of Fox Crossing
- Planning to attend a 4-year college or university as a full-time student
- Minimum cumulative 3.5 GPA
- Involvement in the school community
- Demonstrated leadership
- Financial need will be considered

Award Amount:

One \$2,500 per year renewable scholarship award for up to four years, payable annually in the fall (total \$10,000).

Selection:

Recipients will be recommended each spring by the Community Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee.

Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the <u>Scholarship Portal</u> (https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents *as instructed* in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Portal account updated with their current email address.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to maintain a full-time student status within a 4-year college or university with a minimum 2.5 GPA each semester.
