



Clintonville Area Foundation Glenn and Jenny Goldschmidt Scholarship

Background:

Jenny and Glenn Goldschmidt were raised in Wisconsin and graduated from public high schools. Both went on to receive bachelor's degrees, and Jenny went on to receive a master's degree - all from Wisconsin State Universities. They are very grateful for the outstanding education they received through Wisconsin's public education systems. Later, Jenny and Glenn relocated to Clintonville for 34 years with Glenn working for the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture for 34 years and Jenny for the Clintonville School District for 29 years. In addition, Glenn went on to have a consulting business until his final retirement.

The Goldschmidts have two boys, Jacob and Bill, both graduating from Clintonville High School. The focus of this scholarship is for a student, upon graduation, to attend a Wisconsin technical school in a field they are passionate about. Jenny and Glenn hope that this scholarship, in a small way, will help a student achieve success.



Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Graduating high school seniors from Clintonville High School
- Planning to attend an accredited technical school within the state of Wisconsin as a full-time student
- Demonstrated focus and commitment to studies and academic improvement, even if not performing at the highest level
- Demonstrated desire to further their education through a technical degree
- Extracurricular activities, community involvement and work history are considered
- Financial need will be considered

Award Amount:

One \$500 non-renewable scholarship award for cost of attendance, payable for the first semester.

Selection:

Recipients will be recommended each spring by the Clintonville High School Scholarship Selection Committee.

Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the <u>Scholarship Portal</u> (https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents as instructed in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Portal account updated with their current email address.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student for the first semester of freshman year at an accredited technical school within the state of Wisconsin.
