



Chilton Area Community Foundation Levi T. Cummings Memorial Scholarship

Background:

Levi T. Cummings graduated from Hilbert High School in 2011. He participated in football, wrestling and track, and participated in the Hilbert Athletic Association summer baseball league. Levi graduated with honors from UW-Oshkosh with a degree in finance and worked at Northwestern Mutual as a financial advisor. He was awarded the prestigious "100 Lives" Award in his first year at Northwestern Mutual, which has only been accomplished by less than 5% of their employees since 1857.

Levi was a fun-loving kind of guy who enjoyed spending time with friends and family. He passed away tragically in a snowmobiling accident at the age of 23. Levi's family and friends would like to continue to celebrate his life by offering a scholarship in his memory. Establishment of this scholarship will aid a Hilbert High School graduate who shares Levi's passion of helping others reach financial security.



Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Graduating seniors from Hilbert High School
- Planning to attend an accredited university, college, or technical college pursuing a business degree
- Minimum cumulative 2.5 GPA
- Strong work ethic
- Participation in extracurricular and community activities

Award Amount:

One non-renewable \$1,500 scholarship award for tuition expenses, payable upon successful completion of the first semester of post-secondary school.

Selection:

Selection will be recommended by the Hilbert High School Scholarship Selection Committee along with a member of Levi's family.

Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the <u>Scholarship Portal</u> (https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents as instructed in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Portal account updated with their current email address.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student pursuing a business degree for the second semester of freshman year of college with a minimum 2.5 GPA for first semester.
