

# **Oliver E. Sweikar Scholarship**

Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Graduating seniors from the following schools in Manitowoc County:
  - Kiel High School
  - Manitowoc Lincoln High School
  - Manitowoc Lutheran High School
  - Mishicot High School
  - Reedsville High School
  - Roncalli High School
  - Two Rivers High School
  - Valders High School
- Planning to pursue a career in electronics, electrical engineering, or related engineering field at an accredited 2-year technical college or 4-year college or university as a part-time or full-time student
- Minimum cumulative 2.5 GPA
- Financial need will be considered

### Award Amount:

- Up to 4 awards to students attending a 4-year college or university: \$6,000 annual scholarship, renewable for up to 4 years (total \$24,000), payable for the fall semester.
- Up to 2 awards to students attending a 2-year technical college: \$4,000 annual scholarship, renewable for up to 2 years (total \$8,000), payable for the fall semester.

### Selection:

Recipients are recommended each spring by the Community Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee.

### **Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:**

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the <u>Scholarship Portal</u> (https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents *as instructed* in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Portal account updated with their current email address.

### Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to maintain a part-time or full-time status majoring in electronics, electrical engineering, or a related engineering field, as a student in good academic standing.

Students changing their major should contact the Community Foundation to verify continued eligibility.
