

Stephen M. Tremel 'Above and Beyond' Fellowship

Background:

The Stephen M. Tremel 'Above and Beyond' Fellowship was created in 2012 to recognize and honor Steve on his 25th anniversary at Liberty Hall Conference Center. Steve is recognized for his unwavering commitment to accomplish any goal he sets out to achieve. His character is a model for honesty and integrity. He is steadfast, focused, loyal and goes 'above and beyond' what is expected.

Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Sophomore or junior male college students entering their junior or senior year at St. Norbert College as a full-time student
- Graduated from a high school in the Fox Cities (Appleton, Hortonville, Kaukauna, Kimberly, Little Chute, Menasha, Neenah)
- Pursuing a degree (major or minor) in Theology & Religious Studies or in Peace & Justice
- Minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA for the first 2 years of college
- Demonstrated learning outside the classroom, such as participation in activities, career development, and/or involvement in community service/service to others
- Demonstrated "life well-lived," centered on Norbertine and Roman Catholic values, and continually doing good work by inspiring and improving the lives of others
- Demonstrated ability to go above and beyond
- Students may apply each year they are eligible

Award Amount:

Two \$5,000 non-renewable scholarship awards for tuition expenses for fall semester.

Selection:

Recipients are recommended each spring by Community Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee along with Mike Van Asten.

Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the <u>Scholarship Portal</u> (https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents *as instructed* in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Portal account updated with their current email address.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student entering their junior or senior year at St. Norbert College, in De Pere, Wisconsin, pursuing a major or minor in Theology & Religious Studies or Peace & Justice.
